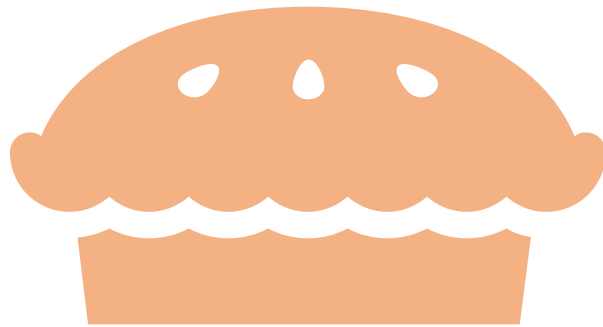
The ward Christmas party will be taking place on December 4th at 5:00pm, at our ward building.
